THE COORDINATING COUNCIL OF ALCOHOLICS ANONYMOUS IN SAN DIEGO COUNTY

The 380th meeting was called to order at 8:00 P.M. by chairman Chuck H. Traditions were read by Jerry C. Roll check by Harriet N. 63 groups were represented. Minutes approved as read.

BUSINESS COMMITTEE report given by Mary Lee J. who reported the new schedules will be ready May 13th. Mary Lee reported due to the cost factor involved try not to misuse them. Mary Lee thanked all the persons involved with putting the schedule together.

Hal C. made a motion, seconded by Stu W. that groups listed in the Coordinator who continually have double 000's back to Jan. 1977 be dropped from the Coordinator due to space it is impractical to carry them. This is only in the Coordinator.

The Business Committee is making an action study of the 1250 Multilith Machine, since we appear to be committed to commercial printing of the schedules. Stu W. reported on the New Years Eve Dance which will be held at the War Memorial Bldg. with Buck Wayne's Band. It will be on a first come first serve bases as there will be only 600 tickets sold to comply with the Building regulations.

PROGRAM COMMITTEE report given by Rea B. who reported all speakers had not been confirmed for the month of May.

PUBLIC INFORMATION COMMITTEE report given by chairman Bill B. who reported 37 facilities covered with 65 speakers participating, who spoke to 1,732 persons. Bill thanked the volunteers who manned the N.A. Booth at the N.C.A. Forum.

OLD BUSINESS:

The Proposed Amendment to the By Laws from the Question and Answer Group died due to a lack of a two-thirds vote.

NEW BUSINESS:

Bob S. made a motion to have the Office Hours of the San Diego And North County Office hours be changed to 8:30 A.M. to 5:00 P.M. Seconded by Bill B. Motion carried.

A discussion regarding the File Cards in the Central Office be up-dated. Mickey W. is at present working on the files and is doing the best she can with the information at hand at the Central Office.

Pat F. was elected to the Program Committee.





The 383rd meeting was called to order by Act ing Chairwoman Mary Lee J. Traditions were read by Tom McK. Roll check by Chuck H. indicated, af ter adjustments, that 58 groups were represented. Motion made and carried to formally approve the minutes of the 381st council meeting. This corrected an oversight at the 382d meeting when formal approval was omitted.

Minutes of the 382d meeting of the council were read by stand-by secremetary Ken W. and were approved as read.

Business Committee report was given by Chairman Hal C. and was susbsequently approved by the council. The financial status of AA in San Diego was discussed, with specific reference to discrepancies in the procedures used by Cunocar Bookkeeping Service, the North County Office and the San Diego Office. This has resulted in differences in the report figures which could not be reconciled at the time of this report. It is believed that an audit, in complinace with the by-laws, will result in the reconciliation of these differences in procedures for the recording of fiancial activities. Hal C. r eported progress in obtaining bids for audit services. The low bidder to date will be reviewed to asure that those services are comparable to the services of other and higher bidders, and that the lower price is for necessary and comparable service. Council gave tentative approval to the Business Committee for the expenditure of the funds for the \$750 cost of audit by the lower bidder, but contingent upon committee finding on service.

Business Committee requested and received council approval for expenditure of funds for the receipted expenses of the Secreatry of the San Diego Office to attend the Southern California Convention as a repr esent ative of this ar ea.

Business Committee reported their action to decline acceptance of a valuable item of duplicating equipment received for the sum of \$1.00 from an outside source. The basis of decline was that acceptance would be in violation of the intent of the traditions and would be contrary to the best interest of AA in San Diego. The Chairman is preparing a letter of thanks to the intended donor with an explanation of the reasons .

On the question raised at the previous meeting concerning the propriety of offering for sale and profit of Central Office, the reproduced memorabilia of Jim & Rosa B., it was the opinion of Hal C. Chairman, that comment was not, at this time, an appropriate matter for the Business Committee. This opinion is based upon the fact that there is no current recommendation or request for action or funds before the council which requires action at this tiem. Therefore, action on suggestions made by Rosa B. at the 5 July meeting of the Business Committee is not considered appropriat e at this time.

The Business Committee requested and received council approval on the expenditure of \$13.59 to reimburse the Ad Hoc Committee for expenses incurred. Further, that the Business Committee endorses the Ad Hoc Committee request and recommendation to spend several weeks monitoring the procedures and activities of employees and volunteers working at Central Office. Times are to be arranged and coordinated with the Chairman and the Secretary. The Ad Hoc Committee has expressed their concern over the volume of gifts, mementos and other non-AA approved items on inventory and being handled through Central Office, and the danger of violation of requirements for our tax-exempt status. It was recommended and endorsed that any monies related to handling of non-AA items (ie: Praying Hands Cigarette Lighters, Ballpointpens, plagues, pins, etc) be so separated and separately recorded as to assure they are not mixed with regular AA Office funds for AA litera ture or group contributions. The Chairman of the Business Committee will make arrangements for this separate accounting by the Cent ral Office Secretary responsible for handling funds.

Program Committee report given by Co-Chairman Agnes W. who indicated all speakers for August were confirmed. Tickets for the 37th Annual AA Banquet will be on sale by the Program Committee on 1 September and the price will be \$10.00 per person.

Public Information Committee report given by Chairman Dale G. who reported that during the past month 23 speakers spoke at 19 institutions to 819 persons. Dale advised two radio st ations had contacted him for public information assistance. That the Mira Mesa Junior Women's Club invited AA to man a booth at their Helath Fair to be held Aug 27, and that a special AA meeting would be held at UCSD Campus at Rm. 2113 Applied Civics & Math Bldg on Monday 22 August at 7:30 p.m. Persons intersted in any of these activities contact Dale.

Under Old Business, the Ad Hoc Committee recommended a history of AA <u>locally</u> be prepared. That Tom B., one of the earliest members in the area offered to cooperate with and consolidate the recollections of various "old-timers" in the area to prepare such a history. How ever, Tom B. specified that the history would not be prepared for purposes of being sold. The intent is to retain such information as is available from older members while they are still alive and available to offer their recollections to the local members of the fellowship. The council unanimously endorsed the concept that Tom B. work with older members of AA to prepare a local history of AA in San Diego County in some form that will be available to, but not sold to the membership. The period to be covered will be from approximately 1940 through 1952 when the current biructure of AA in San Diego was established.

Bob S. reported the AA picnic would be held at Admiral BAker Field on August 14th from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. Tickets for \$1.00 are now on sale and will be available at the picnic. Two male members of the Program Committee were appointed. They were Don B. and Jim R. There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 1:10 p.m.

COORDINATING COUNCIL MEETING

The 384th meeting of the council was called to order at 8:00 P.M. by chairperson Harriet N. Roll check by Mary Lee J. 56 groups were represented.

Minutes of previous meeting accepted after two corrections by Hal C. (1) Under report given by the Chairman of the Business Committee, it was stated that the financial status of A.A. in San Diego County, with specific reference to discrepancies in the Cunocar Bookkeeping Service, North County Branch Office and San Diego Central Office. This was a false and misleading statement and should have beem recorded to read that the Business Committee had taken exception to the distributation of the Net Income by the Cunocar Bookkeeping Semi-Annual Balance sheet and the committe was presenting it to the council with reservations. There was no reference made to any discrepances in the San Diego Office or the No. County Branch Office. (2) Minutes read that Hal C. reported that Business Committee recommended and endorsed that any monies related to handling of Non A.A. items be seperated and seperately recorded. This should have been recorded to read that Hal C. reported that Non A.A. items be displayed seperate and apart from A.A. World Service Materials.

BUSINESS COMMITTEE report given by Hal C. who reported prior to conducting any official business the committee received a report from two members of the Ad Hoc committee; Chuck K. and Marty L.

The Business Committee approved the Income and Disbursement statement for August as presented.

Hal explained the "Birthday Donations" the Committee felt that some A.A. members may not be aware of the practice often observed by several members to donate to the Central Office one dollar (\$1.00) for each year of sobriety as an expression of their gratitude.

Hal reported with action taken by the Council to conduct an audit of Central Office books. The Business Committee contracted with Jassoy, Graff & Douglas to begin the Audit at a revised cost of "not to exceed \$1,000.00."

The Business Committee instructed the Central Office Secretary to comply with the wishes expressed by some of the No. Co. groups and credit all contributions made by North County groups to the North County Branch Statement of Income and Expense.

Hal reported that Iona H. would research the files for existing documents and revise the Central Office Operating Manual and Personnel Policy Manual.

The Business Committee voted to withdraw five thousand dollars from the regular Savings Account and purchase a six year Time Deposit Certificate at Home Federal Savings.

Resignation of two members from the Public Information Committee, Dale G. and Fran P. was reported to the Business Committee. These vacancies to be filled at the October Council Meeting.

Motion by Iona H. that the council chairman instruct the Coordinating Council Secretary to publish in the Coordinator only on action taken as reported by ALL standing committee or Special Committee Chairmen.

Business Committee report approved by Coordinating Council motion. (MSC)

PUBLIC INFORMATION COMMITTEE report given by chairman Dale G. who reported that during previous month 19 speakers spoke at 18 facilities to 710 persons.

In addition Caroline W. was interviewed on KSDO radio and Dona Marie S. was interviewed on KOGO radio. 75 members and Non-A.A. members participated in a special meeting held at the UCSD Campus Aug. 22. A.A. members manned an A.A. information booth at the Mira Mesa Health information Fair Aug. 27.

PROGRAM COMMITTEE report given by Co-chairman Bill P. who reported all speakers confirmed for month of September. Bill said a application for Banquet tickets would be in the Coordinator. Tables will seat eight, only 500 tickets will be sold and these will be on a first come first serve basis.

Frances N. secretary of the Program Committee will not be able to serve for the next few weeks due to illness, the Council elected Fred to fill the vacancy until Frances is able to return.

Mike B. (Female) was elected to the Program Committee.

Harriet N., chairperson reported the Co-Editor of the Coordinator, Ellen McI., has sent in a letter of resignation and the vacancy will be filled at the October Council meeting.

COORDINATING COUNCIL MEETING

The 385th meeting was called to order at 8 p.m. by Chairperson Harriett N. Traditions were read by Agnes W. Roll check by Mary Lee J. indicated 54 groups represented of previous meeting read by Standing Secretary Ken W. and approved as read. BUSINESS COMMITTEE report by Chairman Hal C. was approved as presented. Committeemember Dick D. has been absent 3 months and the position is declared vacant. Council action to fill the vacancy will be taken next session. Committee review of September financial state-ment found all items in order. Clarification was made that an audit was ordered because Council By-Laws prescribe it. The departure of Central Office Secretary. Colleen C. was in no way audit-related. She personally acknowledged the timing of her departure was at her own request to allow additional time to move. Her letter of resignation to accept a more lucrative and definitive position was read. A subsequent motion was made and carried to expend the sum of money not to exceed \$100, required to present Colleen with a permanent memento of the fellowship appreciation for her period of employed service. Discussion of the audit report followed. All r eccipted funds were accounted for and found in order. An exception to Cunocar records was taken on a minor item which an earlier audit should have corrected. The item was for \$300 in prepaid ren: shown as an asset which bai, in fact not been so for many years, and prior to the period of service of the departed secretary. Further discussion was tabled to next session when topies of the audit report will be available. A permanent selection of Central Office Secretary will be made in accordance with the By-Laws. Pending this action, Ken W. is installed as standing secretary, and council approved his signature as one of the two required for all check disbursements.

Business Committee brought Council attention to an existing inequity in the pay the Council now authorized for the North County Central Office Secretary Sam M. Who receives less for his full-time services than does his temporary stand-by replacement for a comparable period of work. Because the annual amount requires group approval, the next session of the council will be requested to provide group approval to pay the North County Central Office Secretary an amount of \$537.50 for his full-time services per month - which is the same amount the council already approves as payment to the stand-by replacement for the same work time. The Committee recommended and Council approved deletion of \$30 per month car allowance for San Diego Central Office Secretary. In lieu thereof, 15c per mile and reimbursement for receipted expenses for directed business will be paid to any employee on directed business of Central Office. Council also extended \$200 per annum cash payment, in lieu of medical and accident insurance, to the North County Tentral Office Secretary.

PROGRAM COMMITTEE report given by Agnes W. All speakers for Occober confirmed. Banquet tickets are still available.

PUBLIC IMPORMATION COMMITTEE report not given. No committee members were present. Central Office informs that there are a backlog of requests for my speakers availing committee action. Some are 2d and 3rd requests.

OLD BUSINESS was to select replacement for Ellan Mal as Co-editor of the Coordinator. NEW BUSINESS action elected Paggy S. as the new Co-editor. Council action established the number of pages in the Coordinator is at the discretion of the Editor.

Cliff R., area delegate to GSO New York expressed appreciation for council cooperation. Cooperation between service elements of AA is being stressed. He charified that Birthday Donations of \$1.00 for each year of sobriety are traditionally made by individuals to GSO New York. This should not detract similar local action as well. Cliff advised that new legislation provides assignement to alcohol programs in lieu of r emoval of driving licenses by the courts. As result many profit-oriented programs are being created, often backed by lawyers or professional alcohol counselors and employing members of AA to promote their activities. Cliff suggests local AA groups be alert to such programs and urged the council to reinstitute a committee to cooperate with the professional community. The Chairperson Harriett N. charged the Business Committee with investigating ways to do this which would not require amending the By-Laws. Standing Secretary Ken W informed the council that he has already been approached at Central Office by an AA member requesting the office make literature on a medical decoxification program available at the office. Ken advised him to consult the long form of the traditions in the back of the AA Big Book for guidance on the policy he was following at Central Of fice and recommended groups review the long form of the traditions as the most effective means of resolving questionable matters of the g roup.

Chuck W. was selected for the Program Committee. An Ad-Hoc Committee has been appointed to review applications for the permanent selection of Central Off ice. Secretary. The position is being advertised in the Coordinator.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:40 p.m.

The following is an excerpt from the October-November 1977 "BOS 4-5-9 News and Notes from the General Service Office of A.A. in New York.

DOES) THE G.S. CONFERENCE REALLY 'BOSS' A.A.?

What if some A.A.'s wanted to rewrite the First Step? Or drop the Eleventh and Twelfth Traditions?

If they happened to be members of your own group's steering committee -- or if they belonged to some other A.A. committee or board, or worked in some A.A. service office -- would that give them the "right" or "authority" to change our Steps and Traditions without consulting the rest of us?

If we cherish our freedom in A.A., we ought to look into such matters. By reading the Conference Charter, we'd find we are insulated against exactly such power-drivers by our General Service Conference.

Established by our Society in 1955 (after a five-year trial run), the Conference has the obligations and the power that are clearly set forth in this charter. It contains a few simple ideas that make it possible for our unorganized Fellowship to get certain basic tasks for drunks done in an efficient, orderly way, without legalistic folderol.

The first section reads: "1. Purpose: The General Service Conference of Alcoholics Anonymous is the guardian of the world services and of the Twelve Steps and Twelve Traditions..... The Conference shall be a service body only; never a government...."

Like other A.A. ideas, this turns out to concern the heart more than the mind, although it is rooted squarely in practical down-to-earth common sense.

As we know, many (maybe most) A.A.'s dislike intensely anyone's trying to exercise authority over us. So the ordinary organization style -- hierarchy of power with authority flowing from the top -- is turned topsy-turvy in AA. Given enormous responsibility, the Conference is told it must serve the Fellowship, never govern it.

COORDINATING COUNCIL MEETING

The 386th meeting of the Council was called to order by Chairwoman Harriett N. at 8 pm on 3 Nov. 1977. Traditions were read by Bill L. Roll check by Mary Lee J. ultimately indicated that 61 groups were represented. Minutes of the previous meeting were read by Standing Secretary Ken W. and corrected to reflect that Chuck C. was the selection for the Program Committee rather than Chuck W. as reported.

Business Committee report by Hal C. indicated that funds for the previous month were found to be in order. He called attention to the format and stated that next month the report would again reflect the break-out of North County items. Of numerous items being reviewed by the Ad Hoc Committee, some were appropriate for action at this time. They were a number of items affecting Central Office employees and pertained to specified holidays, paid vacation time, sick-time benefits and health insurance. Council approved the items presented. Details on the specifics are available from the Business Committee. Copies of the 4-page cover letter and auditors opinion from Jassoy, Graff & Douglas were distributed. After discussion, it was noted that following review by council members, further discussion would probably ensue at the next meeting. There was insufficient interest in having the more lengthy section of the audit report reproduced. However, the Business Committee was charged with preparing a topical outline of the "Housekeeping-type" recommendation in the report which will be available at the next council meeting. The previously announced vacancy on the Business Committee was filled by Bob B. of North County. This partial-term service does not affect Bob's eligibility for future full-term service.

Program Committee report given by Bill P. Not all speakers are confirmed for the month of November. The Anniversary Banquet will be held 5 November 1977 at the Town & Country Hotel.

Public Information Committee report was not given by a committee member. Due to resignations and illness, none were present at this council meeting. Chairwoman Harriett N. covered available information on the committee activities for the month. Bill B. (who is now recuperating from surgery) and Betty M. have filled in and covered the default actions requesting Public Information speakers. Newly elected members to the Public Information Committee are Sully and Charlotte L. The Chairman of the Business Committee solicits in-put from the fellowship of names of qualified members interested in future service on the Public Information Committee.

Under old business, the council approved paying the North County Central Office Secretary the amount of \$537.50 per month for his full-time services. Peggy S., the newly elected Co-Editor of the Coordinator has advised that, according to the sobriety requirements specified in the Council By-Laws, she is short of the time specified for the position. Further, that she will, as a volunteer, continue to assist the Editor Bob S., regardless of title or status, if her services are desired. Officially, the position of Co-Editor of the Coordinator is now declared to be vacant, and may be filled by a qualified and interested member of the fellowship.

New business consisted of a report of activities of the San Diego Institutional Committee by Charlie T. The packet of information he presented to the Secretary is available to any interested members of the fellowship, and is retained at the Central Office.

Pat F. requested clarification of previous council discussion about the practice of selling non-conference approved it ems, such as cigarette lighters, at Central Office, and wanted to know if these items would continue to be sold through Central Office. Hal C. stated that such memorabilia and trinketry was still being sold, but that stocks were reduced and had not been recently re-ordered. The re-order policy is under review and additional comments on the sale of these items, and the implications to our tax-exempt status will be made at the next council meeting. *(NOTE: Excerpts of minutes of previous meetings pertaining to this subject are reproduced below)

Bob S. made a motion to adjourn. The meeting was adjourned at 9:40 p.m.

* * * * * * * * * * * * *

* Minutes of 383rd council were prepared as follows: "The Ad Hoc Committee has expressed their concern over the volume of gifts, mementos and other non-AA approved items on inventory and being handled through Central Office, and the danger of violation of requirements for our tax-exempt status. It was recommended and endorsed that any monies related to handling of non-AA items, ie: Praying Hands Cigarette Lighters, Ballpointpens, plaques, pins, etc be so separated and separately recorded as to assure they are not mixed with regular AA Office funds for AA literature or group contributions. The Chairman of the Business Committee will make arrangements for this separate accounting by the Central Office Secretary responsible for handling funds."----- At the 384th council meeting this segment was corrected as follows: "Minutes read that Hal C. reported that Business Committee recommended and endorsed that any monies related to handling Non A.A. items be seperated(sic) and seperately recorded. This should have been recorded to read that Hal C. reported that Non-AA items be displayed seperate and apart from AA World Service Materials."
