What is it?

- The Coordinating Council of AA San Diego is our local Intergroup association

Why should I become a Coordinator?

- Each individual AA group is entitled to representation in the Coordinating Council yet of the 757 registered groups in San Diego less than 80 have a coordinator

What are my responsibilities as a coordinator?

1. **Attend One Monthly Council Meeting!!** - Second Thursday of *each* month at 7:30 in Mission Valley.
2. **Keep Your Group Informed!!** - Report actions and plans of the council back to your group
3. **Have A Voice!! - Bring any issues to the council that may affect AA as a whole** – Are there specific issues that your group's conscience feels needs attention?
4. **Have A Vote!! - Vote on behalf of your group's conscience on issues set before the council** - Did you know there was recently on vote to allocate funds to establish an Archives Room at Central Office? Did your group have a vote?
5. **Get Involved!! - Vote in the election of the officers and members of the standing committees:**
After-Hours Phones, Business Committee, Coordinator Outreach, Coordinator Newsletter, Orientation and Guidelines Committee, Program Committee and Public Information Committee.
